

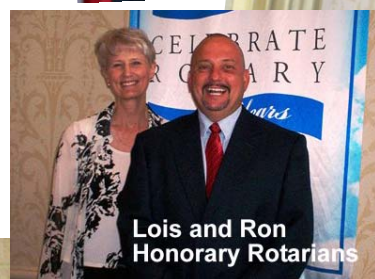
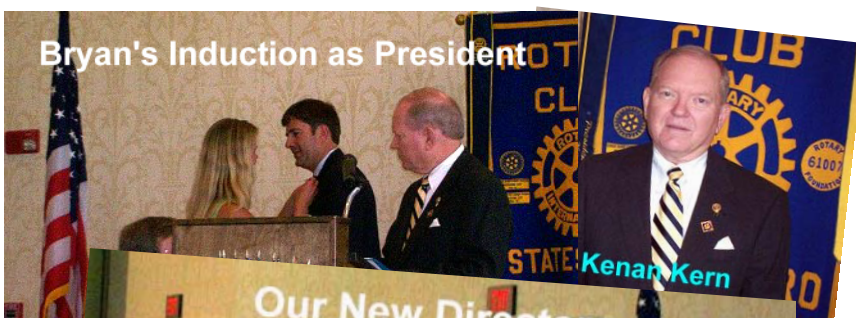

**Statesboro’s Agricultural College**

“The newspaper in Statesboro learned early in 1906 of the state’s plan to open a new industrial and agricultural school in the First Congressional District. Immediately the editor summarized local opinion: “We want that



college.” Although several communities in southeastern Georgia submitted bids on December 1, 1906, the Statesboro–Bulloch County delegation made certain theirs—the equivalent of \$125,500—was the highest.”
